
Emancipet - Emancipet understands the importance of TNR programs and has a policy of never turning away a cat in a trap if it is within their power to add it into the surgeries scheduled for the day. Spay/neuter services will be provided at Emancipet for \$69 and will include a tattoo and an ear tip. Services for feral cats are not available on the mobile unit.




